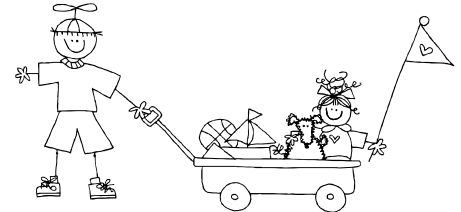




SUMMER ACCELERATED PROGRAM: In addition to our regular summer camps, we will be providing an opportunity for students entering grades 3-8 to keep their math and reading skills sharp this summer. Our library will be open and, under teacher guidance, students can take an Accelerated Reader or Accelerated Math Test. They will also be able to obtain printouts of math problems to work on at home and test the following week. Due to inventorying of our library books, the students will not be able to check out books, but can use the Mt. Greenwood or Evergreen Park Library. Our Accelerated Reader list is available on our website and also in print at the local libraries. Advanced registration is required in order to prepare for use of Accelerated Math program.

KINDERGARTEN FUN CAMP: This camp, open to students entering kindergarten, will be a fun and exciting way to be introduced to the kindergarten program. The children will be introduced to sign language in order to help them recognize letters and associate letters to sounds. We will learn about letters and their sounds while using shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, paints, etc. Math skills will be explored through the use of manipulatives such as unifix cubes, and play dough. The children will also be introduced to Math "touch points" which is a great tool for learning how to add! We will have some free exploration time at the various learning centers (reading & writing, science, math and art). We will also have outdoor recess, play with bubbles and run some fun relay races. Come join in the fun and discover that there is nothing to be nervous about when you enter kindergarten this fall!

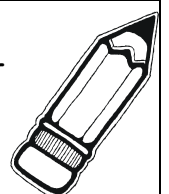

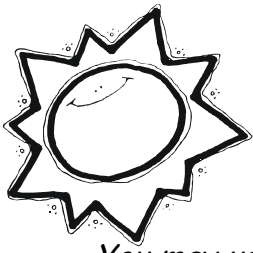
