For example, families that met the \$300 fundraising requirement, will see two notifications (\$300 fee 300 adjustment = no charge). The individual earnings achieved will be reflected on your FACTS statement on book day in August. For the family in the above example that achieved the \$300 goal, they will get a deduction off tuition for the following year. You can start accruing for next year's Manna Fundraising requirement as of May 1st. If you decided not to participate this year, but would like to reduce the \$300 fundraising fee through everyday shopping, please review the flyer below for additional information.

"I Inspire" program launch aimed to help attract, motivate and retain Catholic School Teachers:

A memorial fund was set up in honor of Teri Keaty Joyce aimed to spread the message of love, kindness and support for education as that was a theme in her life. The Teri Keaty Joyce "I Inspire" Teacher Recognition Program has launched in Spring 2024 aimed to recognize the important role teachers play in the lives of children. Teachers everywhere are critical. The teachers choosing to teach in Catholic schools are extra special. A committee of educators formed by the family will invite colleagues, parents, and current 8th Grade students at SJF to nominate ONE teacher that exhibits the criteria below.

- Outstanding care, respect and collaboration with students, parents and colleagues.
- Flexibility in implementing differentiated learning strategies.
- Nurturing of faith, kindness, and patience
- Inspiration of students to be lifelong learners and good-hearted humans

Timeline and Next steps:

- Nomination forms are open with a deadline of May 10 inviting colleagues, parents and current 8th Grade students to use the above criteria to describe the nominee in 250-500 words. An external committee will make selection decisions.
- Cash awards will be announced by the end of the school year at relevant school events in partnership with The Fisher Falcon Education Foundation.
- The program is currently funded for the next three years based on the generosity of Teri's family and friends who wanted to give back to this unique close-knit community where many family members call home. Its impact will reach Queen of Martyrs, where Teri taught, and SJF and MHR, where her 8 grandchildren attend.


