

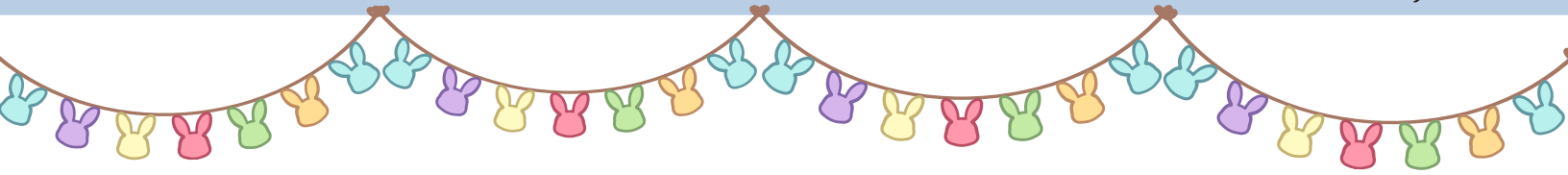











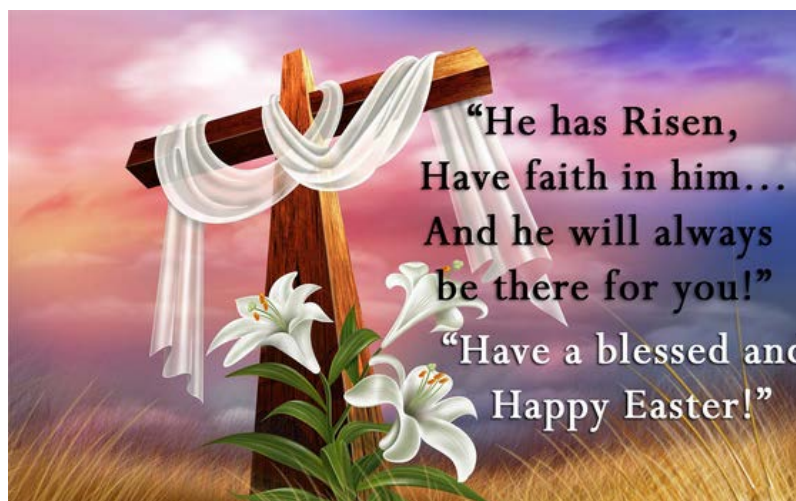
Important Announcements

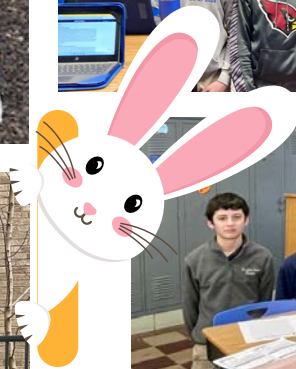

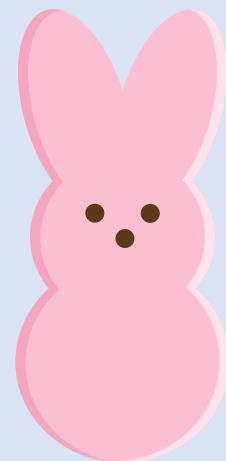

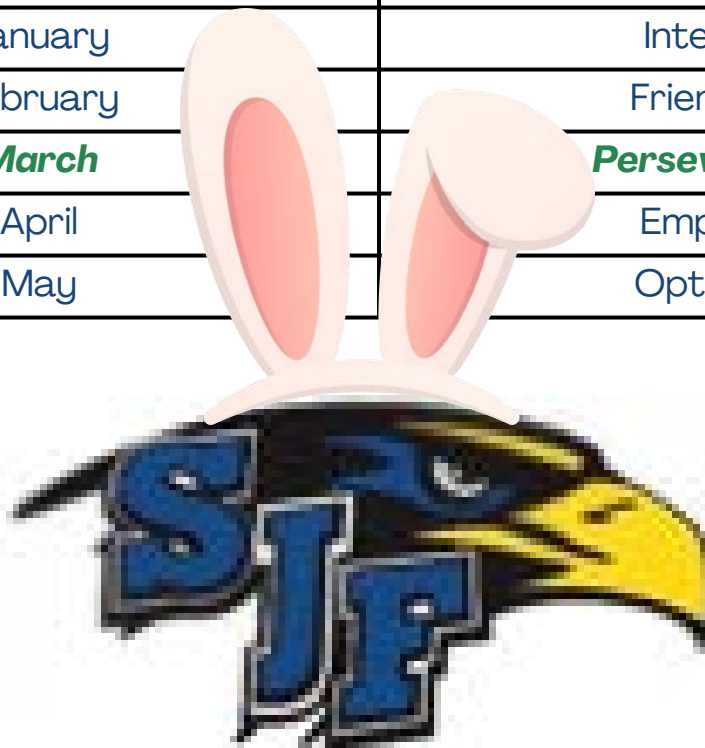


Social & Emotional Learning
