

Summer Programs at St. John Fisher 2009



EARLY CHILDHOOD FUNSHINE CAMP: St. John Fisher is offering an early childhood program for the summer. The program is open to all toilet trained three, four and five-year old children. It is a five-week program taught by the preschool teachers. Each week will be based on a theme. We will explore each theme through stories, songs, arts & crafts, and creative play, both indoor and outdoor. The children will be involved in hands-on activities encouraging social skills and cooperative learning. Class size will be limited to ensure your child's safety and enjoyment. Please send your child to camp each day with a small snack and drink.

Some fun theme-based activities will include whiffle ball, beach ball volleyball, and relay races. We will spend plenty of time in the SJF gym, and some time at outdoor activities as well. On hot days, we will cool off with some enjoyable water activities. Our objective is to guide and teach the young athletes while promoting self-esteem and confidence, so each camper realizes their personal contribution to the team effort. SUMMER ACCELERATED PROGRAM: In addition to our regular summer camps, we will be providing an opportunity for students entering grades 3-8 to keep their math and reading skills sharp this summer. Our library will be open and, under teacher guidance, students can take an Accelerated Reader or Accelerated Math Test. They will also be able to obtain printouts of math problems to work on at home and test the following week. Due to inventorying of our library books, the students will not be able to check out books, but can use the Mt. Greenwood or Evergreen Park Library. Our Accelerated Reader list is available on our website and also in print at the local libraries. Advanced registration is required in order to prepare for use of Accelerated Math program.

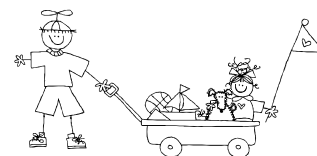



KINDERGARTEN FUN CAMP: This camp, open to students entering kindergarten, will be a fun and exciting way to be introduced to the kindergarten program. The children will be introduced to sign language in order to help them recognize letters and associate letters to sounds. We will learn about letters and their sounds while using shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, paints, etc. Math skills will be explored through the use of manipulatives such as unifix cubes, and play dough. The children will also be introduced to Math "touch points" which is a great tool for learning how to add! We will have some free exploration time at the various learning centers (reading & writing, science, math and art). We will also have outdoor recess and play with bubbles and run some fun relay races. So, come join in the fun and discover that there is nothing to be nervous about when you enter kindergarten this fall!

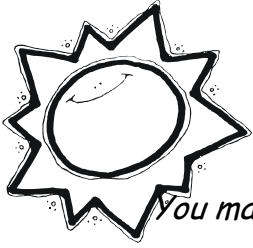

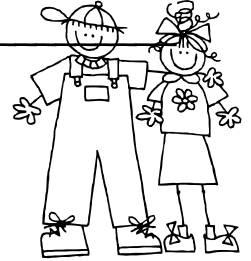
