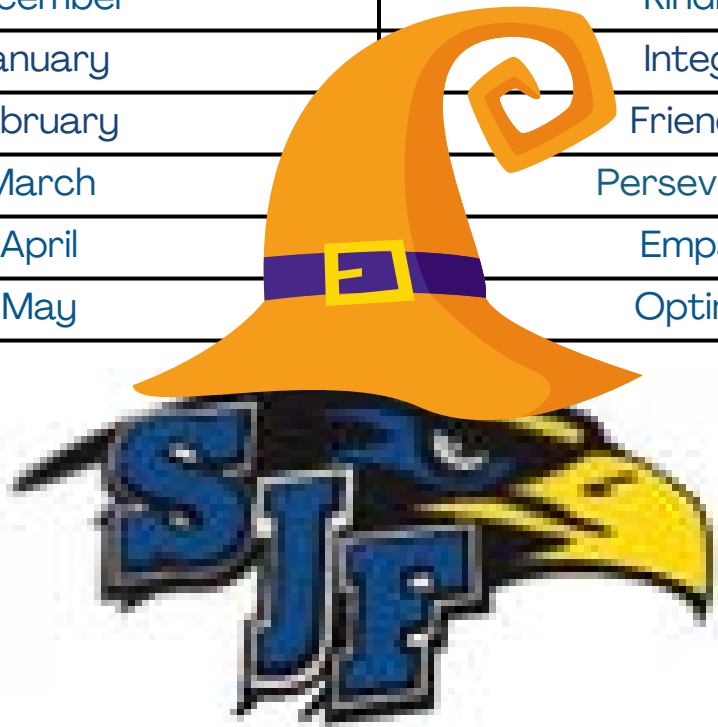


Social & Emotional Learning
