- Sick Policy: Parents are required to keep children home from school the following day if they have been sent home with vomiting, fever (100 degrees), rash or diarrhea. I would like to take this time to thank you for your continued support for our partnership with St. John Fisher and your hot lunch program and for the trust you have put in us to feed your children! This is an endeavor in which we take great pride. We're extremely excited to begin our 7th school year serving the St. John Fisher community.

We're pleased to announce the price of hot lunch will remain at \$6.25 and milk will remain at \$0.85 for the 2024-2025 school year. There will be an added feature to this year's lunch program. You will have the flexibility of ordering a late lunch or milk for your child. Simply send an email to latelunchorder@gmail.com by 4:00am. Indicate your child's school in the subject heading. In the body of the email, please specify your child's name, grade, and the date you are ordering the lunch or milk. In order to utilize this feature, you'll still need to have an active account with myschoolaccount.com and have sufficient funds. Late lunches and milks should only be ordered for dates in which the order window has closed. The price for a "late lunch" is \$7.25 and milk is \$1.00.

This school year our menu will have the addition of more "second option" entrée selections. The selections will include either a salad, wrap, or chicken tenders/nuggets. This will give your child more choices throughout the month. We will continue to specialize in cooking homemade, from scratch meals. Freshness and quality will never be sacrificed. In our kitchen you will always see whole grains, unprocessed meats, and fresh produce. Once again as the year progresses, we will be updating the menu and offering new choices from our home-style recipes.
