## Athletics Pack the House Update

As we approach "Pack the House" for basketball this weekend, we wanted to send out a few reminders to ensure that all students and families are aware of the expectations while in the gym.

- 1. Please remind players to clean up after themselves at the end of their game (remove all water bottles and personal items from the bench and locker room).
- 2. ONLY coaches and players are to be on the bench and warming up. While teams are warming up before a game, there should not be children on the court (this includes the side hoops).
- 3. Please remind teams that are waiting for the game before them to end that they should not be on the court or shooting baskets on the side hoops. This can be distracting for the teams and refs.
- 4. Shooting baskets between games and during time outs will be up to the discretion of the refs/coordinators.
- 5. Please ask your players to clean up after themselves when they are on the stage cheering on their classmates.
- 6. Children are to be supervised while in the building. There is no running up and down the stairs or sliding down the banister.
- 7. Children who are on the 2nd floor balcony need to be supervised by an adult/parent.
- 8. There are no children allowed behind the concession stand counter.
- 9. The only door that should be used to enter and exit the building is the main entrance.






