




Parent Runner Volunteers: Scan Here to sign up to help with practices.

To request gift cards be sent home with our child, **PLEASE SUBMIT**: the **Manna Waiver Form** - Agreement for Gift Cards to be sent home through school. Submitting this form will signal to the Manna team that you'd like ALL orders to be sent home from school.






