Manna Update

- **The Manna Fundraising Requirement** (\$300/family) **will be added in the FACTS system in the coming weeks.**
 - All families will see a \$300 charge and then it will be adjusted based on the amount earned for the school up until April 30th, 2023. For example, families that met the \$300 fundraising requirement, will see two notifications (\$300 fee – 300 adjustment = no charge). The individual earnings achieved will be reflected on your FACTS statement on book day in August.
 - For the family in the above example that achieved the \$300 goal, they will get a deduction off tuition for the following year.
 - You can start accruing for next year's Manna Fundraising requirement as of May 1st.




