COVID GUIDANCE

We are in this together...thank you for your cooperation!

- If your child or a household member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, please call the school office during the school office hours, 7 a.m. 3 p.m. and/or email attendance@sjfschool.us. We will respond during our regular scheduled office hours.
- Please review the most recent communication from the archdiocese <u>linked here</u>. These guidelines will be reviewed every two weeks and are subject to change.
- A few details to highlight:
 - All symptomatic individuals must remain home, regardless of vaccination status.
 - If symptoms last longer than 24 hours, individuals must receive a negative COVID-19 test or alternative medical diagnosis prior to returning to school.
 - Masks are required for all students and staff indoors regardless of vaccination status.






