First Day of School Reminders

- The first day of school is Wednesday, August 25th which is an 11:30 dismissal. Similar to last year, parents are not allowed in the building on the first day.
- Our staggered arrival times will continue this year in order to ease the morning traffic flow. Students with the last name beginning with letters A-L should arrive at 7:45 a.m. and students with the last name beginning with letters M-Z should arrive at 7:50. Students will be considered late at 7:55.

COVID Update

We are in this together...thank you for your cooperation!

- Please review the most recent communication from the archdiocese <u>linked here</u>. These guidelines will be reviewed every two weeks and are subject to change.
- A few details to highlight:
 - o All symptomatic individuals must remain home, regardless of vaccination status.
 - If symptoms last longer than 24 hours, individuals must receive a negative COVID-19 test or alternative medical diagnosis prior to returning to school.

A Prayer For Our Students






