#### **COVID GUIDANCE & REMINDERS**

- If your child or a household member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, please call the school office, 773-445-4737, during the school office hours, 7 a.m. 3 p.m. and/or email attendance@sifschool.us.
  - o If you contact the school office outside of regular scheduled office hours, **we will get back to you the next business day**. Thank you for your patience!
- Details to highlight:
  - Please review the most recent communication from the archdiocese <u>linked here</u> which outlines the updated quarantine time frame and guidance.
  - All symptomatic individuals must remain home, regardless of vaccination status.
  - If symptoms last longer than 24 hours, individuals must receive a negative COVID-19 test or alternative medical diagnosis prior to returning to school.
  - Students who tested positive or were exposed to COVID-19 can now return to school after completing a 5-day quarantine.
    - Positive students must quarantine from athletics through days 6-10.
    - Exposed students may participate in athletics but must provide proof of a negative test in order to attend events on days 6-10 following the 5-day quarantine.
    - A presumed <u>90-day immunity window</u> follows proof of a positive test result for individuals who complete(d) the minimum 5-day isolation <u>and</u> remain symptom free.

We continue to pray for those impacted by COVID and any other illness.

Hang in there – we are all in this together.


