Important Announcements

- iReady Update: The half-way mark of the second trimester means we are approaching our second iReady testing period. Beginning Tuesday, and continuing the following week, all students K-8 will complete the reading and math iReady diagnostic tests. If you have any questions or need any additional information, please reach out to your child's teacher. The full staff directory is linked here.
- Calendar Update: The Archdiocese and Office of Catholic Schools (OCS) requires 180 days of learning while the state requirement is 176. Because of the challenges and additional stress that COVID has created, the OCS has communicated to schools that we are able to make changes to the current school calendar allowing us to utilize 4 additional days off. We have decided to save 2 days for inclement weather or an emergency. If we have to close school due to inclement weather, we will not need to learn remotely or via zoom. Scheduled days off will be February 22nd and March 11th. If we do not need to utilize our inclement weather/emergency days, we will add additional days off in the spring/end of the year. Thank you for your flexibility and support!
- January 30th Update Catholic Schools Week Mass and Open House: Unfortunately, due to COVID and the size of our school community, we have to reschedule our traditional school family Open House and Mass. Please mark your calendars for Sunday, March 27th. We will still celebrate Catholic Schools Week internally with fun and safe activities for our students each day. Stay tuned for more detail to come!



COVID GUIDANCE & REMINDERS

- If your child or a household member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, please call the school office, 773-445-4737, during the school office hours, 7 a.m. – 3 p.m. and/or email <u>attendance@sjfschool.us</u>.
 - If you contact the school office outside of regular scheduled office hours, we will get back to you the next business day. Thank you for your patience!
- Details to highlight:
 - Please review the most recent communication from the archdiocese <u>linked here</u> which outlines the updated quarantine time frame and guidance.
 - All symptomatic individuals must remain home, regardless of vaccination status.
 - If symptoms last longer than 24 hours, individuals must receive a negative COVID-19 test or alternative medical diagnosis prior to returning to school.
 - Students who tested positive or were exposed to COVID-19 can now return to school after completing a 5-day quarantine. Students who participate in athletics or SJF extracurricular activities must provide proof of a negative test in order to attend events on days 6-10 following the 5-day quarantine.
 - Masks are required for all students and staff indoors regardless of vaccination status. This rule INCLUDES athletes, coaches, and spectators indoors at sporting events.
 - A *close contact* constitutes being within 3 feet of a positive individual, un-masked for more than 15 minutes. If your child is considered a close contact, you will be contacted separately and will receive specific quarantine guidance.
 - Updated Athletic Guidance per the Archdiocese: If a student-athlete tests positive, all of his/her teammates will be considered close contacts and will be required to quarantine. If a teammate is vaccinated and asymptomatic, he/she will not need to quarantine.
 - A presumed **90-day immunity window** follows proof of a positive test result for individuals who complete(d) the minimum 5-day isolation <u>and</u> remain symptom free.
 - In addition to proper masking, SJF cleans and sanitizes desks and tables multiple times throughout the day. Our classrooms are cleaned daily. Our building is deep cleaned every weekend. Our students sanitize their hands upon entering and exiting the classroom/lunchroom.
 - We are following the archdiocese guidance and working hard every day to ensure our children and staff remain healthy and safe and can remain with us for inperson learning.

We continue to pray for those impacted by COVID and any other illness. Hang in there – we are all in this together!
