You will have until 1:00 PM, when gates open to the public, to watch warm-ups from the 100 level.


COVID GUIDANCE & REMINDERS

- If your child or a household member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, please call the school office, 773-445-4737, during the school office hours, 7 a.m. 3 p.m. and/or email <u>attendance@sjfschool.us</u>.
 - If you contact the school office outside of regular scheduled office hours, *we will get back to you the next business day*. Thank you for your patience!

• Details to highlight:

- Please review the most recent communication from the archdiocese <u>linked here</u> which outlines the updated quarantine time frame and guidance.
- All symptomatic individuals must remain home, regardless of vaccination status.
- If symptoms last longer than 24 hours, individuals must receive a negative COVID-19 test or alternative medical diagnosis prior to returning to school.
- Students who tested positive or were exposed to COVID-19 can now return to school after completing a 5-day quarantine.
 - Positive students must quarantine from athletics through days 6-10.
 - Exposed students may participate in athletics but must provide proof of a negative test in order to attend events on days 6-10 following the 5-day quarantine.
- Masks are required for all students and staff indoors regardless of vaccination status.
 This rule INCLUDES athletes, coaches, and spectators indoors at sporting events.
 - Updated Athletic Guidance per the Archdiocese: If a student-athlete tests positive, all of his/her teammates will be considered close contacts and will be required to quarantine. If a teammate is vaccinated and asymptomatic, he/she will not need to quarantine.
- A presumed **90-day immunity window** follows proof of a positive test result for individuals who complete(d) the minimum 5-day isolation <u>and</u> remain symptom free.
- We are following the archdiocese guidance and working hard every day to ensure our children and staff remain healthy and safe and can remain with us for in-person learning.

We continue to pray for those impacted by COVID and any other illness. Hang in there – we are all in this together!














































FEP: BENCHWARMERS

Thank you for partnering with the Chicago Bulls. We look forward to creating an exciting and memorable event for your group. For your convenience, we have provided you with a list of helpful guidelines to ensure you get the most out of your experience.

Entering the United Center

- All attendees can park in any available game day parking.
- Attendees can enter through Gate 6 on the South Side of the building. Gate 6 opens at 12:00.
- Upon arrival, COVID vaccinations, bags, and tickets to the game will be checked.

Inside the United Center:

- Bulls Representative will meet the group outside of section 111-112 on the lower-level concourse.
- As guests arrive, Bulls representative will escort them to section 110-113 to watch warm-ups *behind the hockey dasher boards.*
- When doors open to the public at 1:00, Bulls representatives will escort fans out of the lower bowl.


Day of Event Reminders:
