- The <u>UChicago Impact Parent Survey is now open</u>! Please fill out the parent survey, <u>linked here</u>. Your feedback will be used to continue to make improvements at SJF – thank you for your participation!
- iReady: All SJF students completed a mid-year, iReady diagnostic test. The results will be used to drive both large and small group instruction as it provides teachers with reports which detail students' strengths and areas for growth. While iReady data is informative and useful, it is by no means a perfect assessment; so many factors influence a student's performance especially during a pandemic. We continue to monitor student progress and work to ensure that there are no barriers between students and their potential. As a family, we ask that you continue to emphasize the importance of completing the iReady lessons as they are assigned by your child(ren)'s teacher(s). If you are interested in viewing your child(ren)'s most recent score you can find them on their iReady dashboard under the My Progress tab. 
