Dear Parishioners,

As previewed in the parish newsletter earlier this month and last weekend at masses, we will be holding a parish-wide "town hall" meeting this coming **Tuesday**, **October 5th from 7-9pm in the church** to discuss the Renew My Church process. This is your opportunity to provide feedback on this process and our parish's future structure to the Archdiocese via our local grouping feedback team.

Representatives from our team will open the meeting with some brief remarks about where we're at in the process, the expected timeline for the Cardinal's decision on our future, and the "scenarios" (the Archdiocese's term for possible new parish and school structures within our grouping of SJF, St. Cajetan, and St. Christina) on which we're being asked to provide feedback. Those scenarios, along with some basic comparative information about the three parishes' sacramental and financial stability and additional background details about the Renew My Church process, will be published in the bulletin as well as posted on the school and parish web sites this weekend. Please be on the lookout for that information; I would encourage all to review it ahead of Tuesday's meeting to make our time together as productive as possible.

Once the scenarios are formally presented, we will open the floor to attendees for the rest of the meeting. Above all else, this is a listening meeting for us. While our formal task is not to make a recommendation or ranking of the scenarios, direct, honest, and respectful feedback that states your preferences but also recognizes potential strengths and challenges of each will be extremely helpful to our team as we move forward in this process and do our best to represent the will of the parish to the Archdiocese.

In the meantime, please keep each other and our parish in your prayers. While we do not know exactly where this process will lead us, I am confident that the good work being done all across our parish and school community on a daily basis will preserve and continue to build on the great legacy of SJF and the identity we share as Fisher Falcons.

 - Masks are required for all students and staff indoors regardless of vaccination status.



Compliance Update

2021-2022 SCHOOL VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

The following guidelines are mandated by the Archdiocese of Chicago and apply to all volunteers, chaperones, coaches, scout leaders, and catechists that will help out in our parish and school programs. The Archdiocese of Chicago conducts an annual audit to ensure that all are in compliance with these mandates. That audit is happening now. If you wish to participate with our students as a volunteer, chaperone, and/or coach, please make sure you have completed all the necessary tasks.

If you are planning to volunteer, chaperone, and/or coach at St. John Fisher School this year, here are the Safe Environment Requirements:

- New volunteer/chaperone/coach: Create an account on the Virtus System at www.virtusonline.org.
- If this is a new account, you will be assigned the online Protecting God's Children Training.
- Register and attend the training within 15 days of beginning volunteering.
- If you have a VIRTUS account from another parish/school, please notify Mary Margaret Redmond to add St. John Fisher School to the existing account.
- If your Protecting God's Children is older than 2018, you will be assigned the online recertification training, *Keeping the Promise Alive* through the <u>VIRTUS website</u>. This recertification is *done online*.

Monday, October 11th

- **Name-based Criminal Background Check** by S2Verify submitted in <u>VIRTUS</u> which is a one-time requirement, but rechecked every three years.
- Archdiocesan Standards of Behavior for Church Personnel working with Minors and Vulnerable Adults
 (Formerly Archdiocesan Code of Conduct). This must be read, signed and re- acknowledged yearly through
 VIRTUS.
- Completion of a CANTS 689 Form <u>linked here</u>. This must be completed every year and turned into school;
 DO NOT MAIL.
- Complete the online *Mandated Reporter Training* through www.archchicago.org.
