COVID GUIDANCE

We are in this together...thank you for your cooperation!

- Please review the most recent communication from the archdiocese <u>linked here</u>. These guidelines will be reviewed every two weeks and are subject to change.
- A few details to highlight:
 - o All symptomatic individuals must remain home, regardless of vaccination status.
 - o If symptoms last longer than 24 hours, individuals must receive a negative COVID-19 test or alternative medical diagnosis prior to returning to school.
 - Masks are required for all students and staff indoors regardless of vaccination status.

i-Ready Assessment Update

St. John Fisher is utilizing an assessment tool and implementing an online, instructional program called *i-Ready*. *i-Ready* is an online program that assists teachers in determining students' strengths and areas for growth, personalizing student learning, and monitoring student progress throughout the school year. *i-Ready* enables teachers to meet students where they are academically, as student and teacher reports provide detailed data that can be used to inform instruction.

The *i-Ready Diagnostic* is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit each student's ability. Every question item a student receives during the diagnostic test is based on his/her answer to the previous question. For example, a series of correct answers will result in slightly harder questions, while a series of incorrect answers will yield slightly easier ones. The purpose of this is not to give students a score or grade but to determine how to best support their learning in the future. It is important to discuss the adaptive nature of the test with your child; it can be discouraging for some students to feel as though they are not excelling/succeeding. Arming students with this information usually results in increased confidence on the day they complete the diagnostic exam. We will test all students, K-8, the weeks of 9/13 and 9/20; the first week reading and the next math.

The data the diagnostic assessment yields will inform teachers' instruction, lesson planning and pacing; individualized i-Ready lessons will be utilized, as well, to supplement classroom lessons and meet individual student needs. These lessons are interactive and provide strategic support used to engage students as they learn at their speed and level. Your child's teacher will begin assigning online i-Ready lessons in the classroom and for homework following the i-Ready Diagnostic assessment. Manna Update

There is a lot of positive buzz from teachers and students enjoying the recent investment in electrical upgrades and air conditioning. Did you know that past Falcon families actively participating in Manna led to a school savings that paid for the bill?!?!? Let's continue to build the school's savings to afford key investments. Last year, earnings for the school was \$40,897 while families accrued individual earnings of \$70,756. If all school families participated regularly the school could earn over \$100,000. Reaching this goal together will help the school balance the budget and maintain competitive tuition rates. Manna is our #1 School Fundraiser. We are off to a great start this year with about 50 new users registering for Manna. The top gift certificates purchased last year were: Amazon, County Fair, Marianos, Jewel, Shell Gas, Visa and many local businesses with Rosangelas at the top of the list. 




