SJF SICK POLICY

Parents are required to keep children home from school the following day if they have been sent home with vomiting, fever (100 degrees), rash or diarrhea. If there are symptoms of a communicable disease (reddened eyes, sore throat, fever, headache, rash), please do not expose other children to the possibility of sickness.





SPR Service Day Project 2023 SHOE COLLECTION



September 30 – October 10

Share Your Soles provides the opportunity for people to share new or gently worn shoes to those most in need. Individuals you may never know, meet, or see, will have been given hope and the chance for a better quality of life because of your care, love, and generosity.

As part of the *Share Your Soles* SPR Service Day project – our community of parishes will sponsor a shoe collection. Collection bins will be in the back of each church September 30 - October 10.

- Shoes of all sizes and types are welcome.
- No old or worn out shoes
- No high-heels
- Do NOT rubber band, zip-tie or bag shoes individually

The collection bins will be checked and unloaded 3x throughout the 11-day period. The volunteers for the **October 14, 2023, 10 am – 12 pm – Share Your Soles project** will deliver and sort the shoes at the Processing Facility - 11201 S. Cottage Grove, Chicago.






