

Keep your 1st Grader's Skills Sharp this Summer

Math:

- Math fact fluency is very important. Your child should be able to quickly answer addition facts & some subtraction facts to 20. Here is a great site for practice. You can sign up. <https://xtramath.org/#/signin>
- Math flashcards : Addition & Subtraction
- i-ready math (sign on)

Reading:

Read as many books as you can. You can read to your child or have them read to a sibling at night before bed. They can read alone too. A Summer Reading BINGO challenge will be sent home in your child's report card envelope the last day of school.

Writing:

Make a summer journal! Keep track of the dates by adding a calendar. Have them write in it after something eventful or on a weekly basis. Bound journals can be bought at Dollar Tree. Pick up special markers, pencils and stickers to make it more fun.
