Dear St. John Fisher Families,

We hope you had a great week! Our Falcons are continuing to settle into routines, and it has been wonderful to see their excitement for learning grow each day. Thank you for your partnership in helping us start the year strong.

We were deeply saddened to learn of the tragic school shooting in Minneapolis this week. As a Catholic school community, our hearts and prayers are with the students, families, and educators impacted by this heartbreaking event. We also recognize that news like this may weigh heavily on our own children, and we want to reassure you that their safety and well-being are always our top priority here at St. John Fisher. We are currently reviewing and updating our own safety protocols, including our procedures for all-school Mass, monitoring locked doors, and instituting a regular police presence on campus. Our teachers are also reviewing safety procedures and discussing ways to support students as they process this tragedy.

Important to Know

- Manna: Due to the Labor Day holiday, there will be no Manna this weekend.
- Safety: To assure all students are safe and accounted for, please remind your child(ren) to enter and exit through their assigned door each day. While it may sometimes seem quicker to cut through another part of the school, our procedures help us know exactly where each student is at all times.
- Fisher Fest Raffle Tickets: Tickets are available at the rectory if you would like to buy or sell
 additional tickets. They will also be available after all Masses for the next couple of weeks.
- New Lunch Program Meal Manage: We are partnering with a new lunch program called Meal Manage. Parents should have received an email from the company with directions to set up their personal account for their student(s). Please be sure to follow those steps so your child is ready to order. Hot lunches will begin on Monday, September 8th.
- Illness Policy Reminder: Unfortunately, we have had more than a few Falcons who have had to go home sick this week. As a reminder from the school handbook:
- Parents are required to keep children home if there has been an episode of vomiting, fever, rash or diarrhea in the 24 hours before the school day begins. If there are symptoms of a communicable disease (reddened eyes, sore throat, fever, headache, rash) please do not expose other children and staff to the possibility of sickness. Emergency forms should list a contact that is available during the school day.




