
HOLY NAME FOOD DRIVE

Option 1: <u>RaiseRight</u> – Try it! It's easy!

Purchase physical cards, eCertificates or reloadable gift cards WITHOUT LEAVING YOUR HOME using the RaiseRight app.

- 1. Online (via website or app) Go to https://www.raiseright.com/ or download the RaiseRight mobile app.
- 2. Complete the quick sign-up form either on RaiseRight.com or mobile app.
- 3. Select "Join a Program."

- Enter your organization's unique enrollment code to tie your earnings to your organization (Email sjfmanna@gmail.com for the code).
- 5. Complete the fields to create your account.
- 6. Enter and verify your phone number for 2-step verification (2-step verification protects your account if you forget your password or someone is using your account without your permission).
- 7. Set Up Online Payment.
- 8. Place your order. Physical cards can be picked up at SJF during Manna hours.

The school fundraising requirement per family is to raise \$300 FOR THE SCHOOL through Manna sales. Meeting this requirement would result in about a \$450 tuition credit for you each year.
