

St. John Fisher School Board

The St. John Fisher School Board is an advisory group to the pastor and principal. It works together to review, revise and recommend school policies and programs that support all aspects of the school program.

The principal is the executive officer of the Board and is an ex-officio member. He or she can recommend policy to the board but he or she does not have a vote. All decisions and policies are subject to the approval of the Pastor.

Based on previous experience, it is recommended that sub-committees consisting of both Board members and others address important issues that will ensure the stability and growth of the school. These include but are not limited to:

- Overall School program including future planning

- Stewardship, including budgeting, fundraising, alumnae

- Building and Grounds

Any member of St. John Fisher Parish is eligible for appointment to the School Board. When openings are announced, applications are made available at school and on the school webpage. An interview team, familiar with the work and goals of the board interviews the candidates and makes recommendations to the pastor. Their recommendations are based on creating a well balanced board willing to share their time and talents with the school and parish community.

Ordinarily the board meets every other month or as needed.
