Operating Endowment Fund

- To be initially funded by Manna savings
- Set up with primary goal to subsidize annual school operating budget
- Supports continued classroom/curriculum enrichment and faculty retention goals



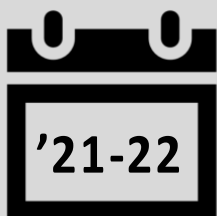
Tuition Assistance & Scholarship Funds

- School & SAB previously reserved funds for tuition assistance
- Ensures SJF can serve families in financial need and/or emergency situations
- Goal to expand reach of Msgr. McElligott awards for graduating 8th graders



Campus Improvement Fund

- Will finance priority plant and building investments (e.g., the recent A/C installation)
- Envisioned to be funded by targeted, episodic fundraisers as building needs are identified
