


#### **Preschool Day**

### Literacy Instruction


- Fundations
- Important skills we work on throughout the year...
  - Upper and Lowercase Letter Identification
  - Upper and Lowercase Letter Formation/Printing
  - Letter Sounds
  - Recognize/Spell/Print First and Last Name (Only first initial uppercase and the rest lowercase!)
  - Rhyming
  - Syllables
  - Beginning Sounds
  - Recognizing Basic Sight Words
  - Understanding that print is read from Left to Right
  - Sequencing and Comprehension

### Math Instruction

- Calendar Math and Question of the Day.
  - · Estimation, Comparing More/Less, Graphing, etc.
- Important skills we work on throughout the year...
  - Number recognition
  - Number formation/printing
  - Counting to 100
  - One to one correspondence
  - Patterning
  - Shapes
  - Sorting and Measurement
  - Subitizing
